Applications should be submitted at least 3 months before the course starts.

10 Bursaries are available for BCDST Class Action Adults who are 54 years old and under.

The BC Deaf Scholarship Trust (BCDST) is offering a limited number of Bursaries. These Bursaries are designed to support the unique learning needs of the JHLT Class Action Members.

Each applicant can apply for up to \$1,000 if you have been accepted in a Community Centre, School, College or University course. The actual amount of the bursary depends on the cost of the course, books, supplies, and interpreters. **Receipts required.**

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the BCDST CA Bursary for Continuing Education you must:

- Be a member of the JHLT Class Action.
- Have proof of the cost of the course and supplies.
- Be 54 years of age or younger in the year of application.
- Be a BC resident for 6 months.

How to Apply:
