10 Bursaries available for members of the BC Deaf Community and JHLT Class Action Members who are 55 years old and older (pilot project).

The Jericho Hill Legacy Trust (JHLT) is offering a limited number of Bursaries. These Bursaries are designed to support the unique learning needs of the British Columbia Deaf Community, including JHLT Class Action Members.

Each applicant can apply for up to \$1,000 if you have been accepted in a Community Centre, School, College or University course. The actual amount of the bursary depends on the cost of the course, books, supplies, and interpreters. **Receipts required.**

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the JHLT Seniors Bursary for Continuing Education you must:

- Be a member of the BC Deaf Community, or a JHLT Class Action Member.
- Have proof of the cost of the course and supplies.
- Be 55 years of age or older in the year of application.
- Be a BC resident for 6 months.
